Pre tour 20 May 2016: The tour leaders searched fruitlessly for **white-throated grasswren** on the escarpment at Gunlom for about six hours.

Top End tour participants were Susanna van Essen (Tas), Martin Painter (HK), Cheryl Taylor (Vic), Peter Turner (Vic), Rosemary Turner (Vic) and Ron Wescott (Vic). John Lombard (NSW) joined us in the last days of part 2 and he and Philip continued on with a personal Top End tour for a couple of days in Darwin. Paul Newman joined the group for **banded fruit-dove** in Kakadu NP.

A party of ten birders along with Philip flew to the Mitchell Plateau on 5 June with Aviair and HeliSpirit in a successful quest to see **black grasswren**.

The general route: Part 1 of this tour saw us kick off in Darwin on 23 June 2016. We departed Darwin on 25 June for Kakadu NP, calling in to Fogg Dam en route. From Kakadu NP, we headed to Pine Creek on 28 June, then Mataranka on 30 June. Part one finished in Katherine on 31 May. We headed to Victoria River that afternoon and on to Timber Creek the next day. Kununurra was home for the next four nights; finally departing Kununurra on 6 June, the morning after a very successful, if very hot, Mitchell Plateau excursion on 5 June.
